

24 Suns -Video installation (Photomontage of trials representation of 8 projections that transmit daylight from 8 different locations)

## My subject is light on a wall

I make a portrait of a wall during the time past, then the portrait is hanged on a wall, who has itself the traces of the passage of the time passed on itself.

The work is trace of an ambient, and mutually, it built an ambient.

I catch with the color the different shades that the wall assumes at the passages of light.

In the 24h painting series each works is made in the temporal unit of a 24 h day, I start at midnight and finish at midnight of the day after .

In the series "spaces" my attention is on the corner, first degree of a minimal space configuration, like a natural referral system of the relativity of light, creativity element of concrete and mental space.

In the series "Bianco Vermeer" I take off from the famous paintings everything but the wall, a ready made process to catch the shades of light on the white.

In 24Suns I take the state of the reflected light on a white wall simultaneously in the 24 time zones of the Earth.

In *Wall to Wall* I transfer the glare produced by a monitor in front of a white wall to another monitor which in turn reflects it on the wall of another place.

In *Monitor* the glow of the monitor on the wall becomes painting.




One of 24 Suns, 2014

The monitor, remotely connected to a webcam pointed at a wall, projecting the light it receives onto another wall.




